

## Holiness

1. Read Isaiah 6:1-8 and Revelation 4  
What is seen of God's nature?  
Is it important to recognise God's holiness?  
What was Isaiah's reaction to God's holiness?  
What was then God's reaction? (Angels move at God's bidding.) Is it good that the two men should in their vision have seen the same things going on in heaven?
2. Read Leviticus 11:39-45, 1 Peter 1:13-25  
Is God's requirement for us any different than for the children of Israel?  
Read 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8, especially verse 7, to confirm this.  
Are you learning how to keep your vessel in honour?  
Who will teach you?  
What sort of things will occur in your life?  
What things were we redeemed with?  
Does this make us of value to God?  
What do you think "gird up the loins of your mind" means?
3. Read Romans 6.  
What should we not let rule in our bodies?(vs.12)  
How?(vs.11)  
Who should we yield our members (parts of our life and body) to?(vs.13)  
What are we to be the servants of?  
What is the fruit of yielding our members unto righteousness?(vs.19)  
What should be the fruit of our lives being God's servants?  
And the end is?(vs.22)  
Is the secret to holiness obeying God?
4. Read James 3 and see what he says about the control over our tongues.  
Should we in any part of our life bring forth "sweet and bitter water"?
5. Read Exodus 28:1-5,29-38,30:22-33  
Look how everything that the priest had on for his ministry in the holy place was holy.  
The garments, the oil, the plate on his head, declared the basis of his work.  
Read Hebrews 12:10, 1 Peter 2:5  
If we are a holy priesthood what must our lives be like?  
Do we need garments?  
Who should we put on? (Romans 13:14)  
What do you think the anointing oil represents for us?
6. Read Ephesians 4:24  
What is our new nature like?  
Is this the basis of our holiness before God? - not outward garments but an inward nature.
7. Read 1 Timothy 2:15, Titus 2:3 about holiness in the lives of women.
8. Read 1 Thessalonians 3:13 to see God's desire for you in all this.  
Is that what we were predestined to? (Ephesians 1:4)  
And why Jesus really came?
