1. Read Isaiah 9:6-7, Luke 1:26-38, Colossians 2:9.

Who do you think this child is who is to be born? What was to be placed on his shoulder? From the things Isaiah says what can you see about the nature (name) of this child?

Does this fit in with the verse in Colossians?

When the angel appeared to Mary and told her of the son that would be born to

was this the fulfilment of the promise of God through Isaiah? Whose son was He to be?

What agent would move on Mary to bring about this miracle?

2. Read Romans 1:3-4 and Hebrews 1.

What does Paul say here about the natural origin of the Lord Jesus?

What does Paul say that really declares Jesus to be the Son of God? Why must this be so?

Does this fit in with Isaiah saying of His government and peace there shall be no end?

Who does Hebrews tell us has God spoken by in the last days?

What did God do through His Son (vs 2) and what has He appointed Jesus to (vs 2)?

What was Jesus like?

What does He do with His word?

What did He do before He sat down? What is His position?

Do you think this is where the government is on His shoulders?

What does God say about His son in this chapter? (vs.5,6,8-9,10-12,13).

Each one of these is a quote from the Old Testament about how God sees His Son and the

position God has given Him with Himself in heaven. Again see how it fits in with Isaiah. A son to be born to have total authority after having purged our sins?

3. Read Matthew 11:25-27 and 16:13-20

What does Jesus say about knowledge of the Son?

How do we get knowledge of the Father? In chapter 16 how did Jesus say Peter

had come to know that Jesus was the Christ, the Son of the Living God?

This revelation was to be the rock on which Jesus Christ will build His church.

4. Read John 1:12-13, Galatians 4:5-7, Romans 8:14-17, 1 John 4:1-6

How do we become children (sons) of God? Who must we receive?

How and of Whom then are we born? Who is our spiritual Father?

What has God done to give us the adoption as sons? What has God sent forth?

Where does He dwell? What will our cry be? What will our cry be?

What are we not any more? Does this mean we are not to serve God?

Who was God's greatest servant? In Romans what are sons led by?

Does the spirit of adoption produce fear? What does it work in us?

What does it witness in our heart? What does being children make us?

What must we do if we are to be glorified together with Him?

In 1 John how is it declared that we are not of antichrist?

Jesus Christ must

have come into our flesh. In John 1:12 it is as many as received Him (same thing.)

John says Ye are of? What is the basis of our position of victory?

What are we not of any more? We are of God.

5. Read 1 Corinthians 1:9

What has God called us into?

6. Read Romans 8, 2 Corinthians 3:17-18, 1 John 3:1-3.

What has God predestinated us to be like? How does this change continue to take place in our lives? What is the manner of love Father has shown us? What are we NOW?

What shall we be like when we finally see Him as He is? Having this hope what should we do?

7. Read Hebrews 5:8 and 12:1-14. What does God do to every son He receives?

8. Read Revelation 21:1-7 What is the promise to him that overcomes?
