1. Read Exodus 33:18 - 34:12.
What did God say that He would do for Moses (vs19)?
Was this promise fulfilled?
What did God declare Himself to be (vs6)?
In this verse The first Lord means Jehovah, which states God to be everlasting, that He always was, always is, and ever will be. The second Lord is El, the Mighty one. He then goes on to describe His character, that of the Lord.
What was Moses' response?
The Lord Moses uses is Adohnahy meaning Master or Sovereign Lord. Why do you think Moses used this word?
What did the Lord make with His people (vs10)?

2. Read Genesis 17:1-8
What did God declare himself to be to Abraham? The word for God here is El Shaddai the almighty God. What did he go on to make with Abraham?
The word for God in verse 3 is Elohim which is plural signifying the trinity of God. Read Genesis 1: 1 where Elohim (plural) the trinity together created (singular) showing that they were one in their desire and action. This is bourn out in statements like John 1:3 (Jesus) and Genesis 1:2 (the Holy Spirit).

3. Read Genesis 17:1, 21:33, Exodus 20:5, Deuteronomy 32:4, 10:17, 4:31, 7:9, 7:21, & Joshua 3:10 and make a list of the attributes of God.
The word here is El the strong or the first.
Read Revelation 1:1-14
How many of the above list can you find here relating to the Lord Jesus?
Read Hebrews 1:8-9, 4:14-16, Luke 22:31
What can you find here?
You should have found every attribute about "El" to be also about Jesus!

4. There are a number of titles of the Lord in the old testament for example Jehovah -Tsidkeenu "The Lord our righteousness."
We will look them all up and find each one declared in the life of Jesus:
 - a) Genesis 22:14 The Lord will provide (or see) : John 6:5-14.
 - b) Exodus 15:26 The Lord that healeth thee : John 5:1-10.
 - c) Exodus 17:15 The Lord my banner : Acts 3:12-16.
 - d) Exodus 31:3 The Lord that sanctifies you : Hebrews 2:10-12.
 - e) Judges 6:24 The Lord our peace : John 14:27 & Ephesians 2:14
 - f) Psalm 23:1 The Lord is my Shepherd : John 10:1-18.
 - g) Psalm 7:17 The Lord Most High : Ephesians 1: 20-23, Philippians 2:9-11.
 - h) Jeremiah 23:6 The Lord our Righteousness : Romans 5:15-21, Philippians 3:8-9. & 1 Corinthians 1:30
 - i) Ezekiel 48:35 The Lord is there : Acts 18:9-11
Matthew 28: 19-20.
